- A. "Community service" is defined as voluntary work which is done to benefit the community or particular groups of people in need. Examples include volunteering at a soup kitchen, visiting a local nursing or veterans' home, completing projects to benefit the environment, or coordinating a care package drive for deployed troops.
- B. Public events, such as parades, color guards, recruiting drives, or other activities that only benefit the USNSCC or the unit do not constitute "community service."
